Program Features and Benefits

- The WAICU Risk Management Program was authorized by the Board in 1995.
- Colleges in neighboring states have been admitted on a case-by-case basis with the goal of increasing potential dividends for WAICU members.
- WAICU is licensed as an insurance intermediary so that we may participate fully within the law in self-insured and fully insured program development and operations.
- Participants in the WAICU program enjoy better rates and better coverage than they could find on their own, including value-added features that would be difficult, if not impossible, to obtain outside of the WAICU group.
- The packages include property, automobile, general liability, liquor liability, professional liability, crime, boiler, and inland marine coverage.
- Additional policies cover educators' legal liability, foreign risks, fiduciary risks, workers compensation, and umbrella coverage.
- WAICU will continue to monitor the insurance market for new approaches to risk management programs.
