- The WAICU Benefits Consortium (WBC) is a comprehensive, collaborative, jointly administered, self-funded health plan developed for the members of (WAICU).
- The objective of the WBC is to offer WAICU members long-term stability and value in what continues to be a volatile health insurance environment.
- Dental and vision options were added to the plan January 1, 2005.
- The WBC is organized under federal law as a voluntary employee benefit association (VEBA) Trust.
- In the WBC plan, no profits are generated and no commissions are paid.
- Efficiency in the WAICU office means operational expenses for the WBC are at a remarkably low percent of revenue, leaving a substantial percent of contributions available to pay claims.
